- 3. Chair's Annual Report for 2021-22
 - There were two Scotton Feasts held during the year, which were a great success.
 - The annual Halloween Party was a highlight for the children.
 - The first Bonfire Night event with BBQ, bar and stalls raised over £1,000 for the school.
 - Other fundraising included tea towels, cake sales, Sports Day and concert.
 - It was easier to get volunteers for the Scotton Feast held in July 2022 and securing a licence for the raffle enabled tickets to be sold in advance.
 - The PTA was able to purchase 20 iPads, Christmas books, leavers' hoodies, a bouncy castle for the leavers and a tree to be planted in Spring.
 - The PTA constitution still needs reviewing asap.
 - Vicky is stepping down as Chair but is leaving the PTA in a good place.
 - Thanks to Miss Calvert, Barry, Lizzy and the year reps for their support.
- 4. Treasurer's Report for 2021-22
 - £4,500 spent on 20 iPads has meant reduced reserves but increased income this year.
 - Easyfundraising needs to be promoted more.
 - The amount raised from the Scotton Feast in July is unknown as it is in a holding account awaiting a decision by the PTA as to whether to donate it to the multi-use games arena (MUGA) fund.
 - The balloon race raised a good amount for minimum effort this could be done again.
 - Tea towels and Christmas cards are alternated.
 - Action Ask Kate Horner-Ashworth if she is happy to sort the Christmas cards this year.
