Next Week's Topics

Reception will be focusing on people who help us in the community. They will also be having a sports day practice on Wednesday – please wear PE kits. Please also log into Tapestry to see Miss Black's challenge for this weekend!

Parents will need to provide written instruction to teachers for any specific individual needs.
